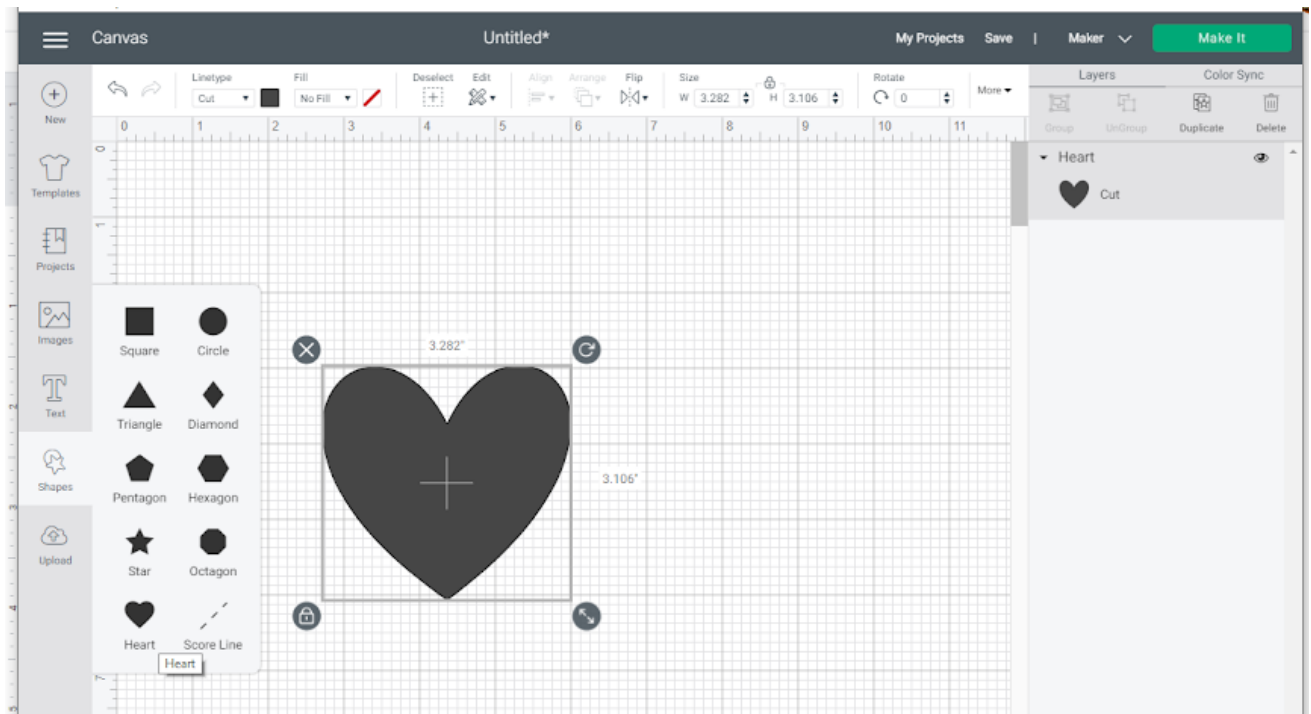


Instructions for Valentine's Card on Cricut Design Space

Step 1

Add Heart shape

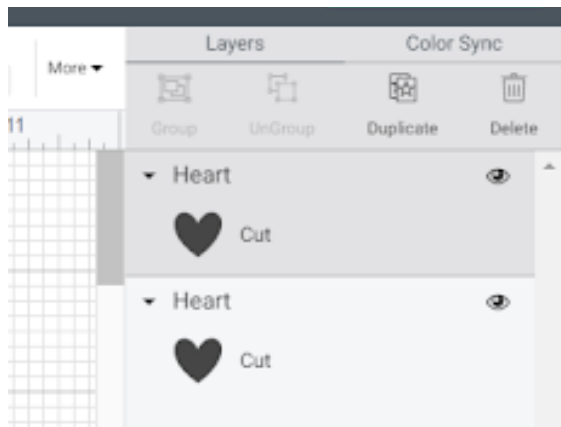


Step 2

**Click and drag to change size to something between 5 - 6 inches.
Do not make the heart larger than 6 inches.**

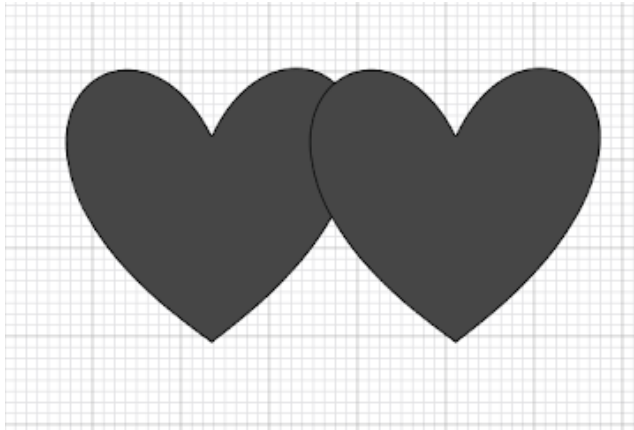
Step 3

Duplicate the heart layer.



Step 4

Drag the second heart so that they overlap by just an inch.



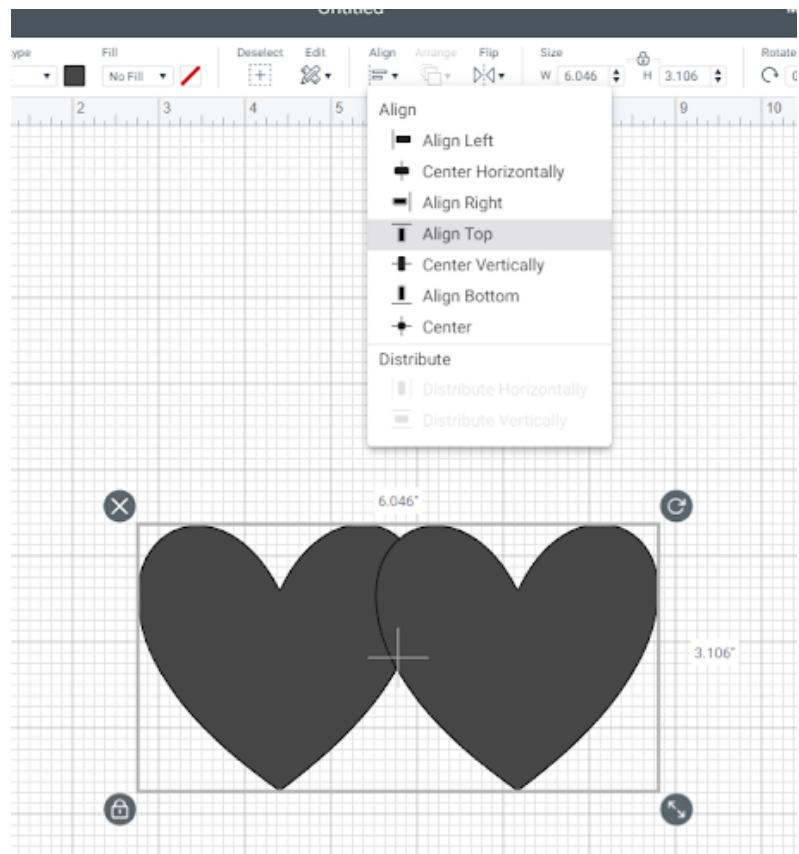
Step 5

Hold shift and click both hearts so that they are both selected. (You will know that they are both selected because the grey box will be around both of the shapes.)

Align the top so they are even.

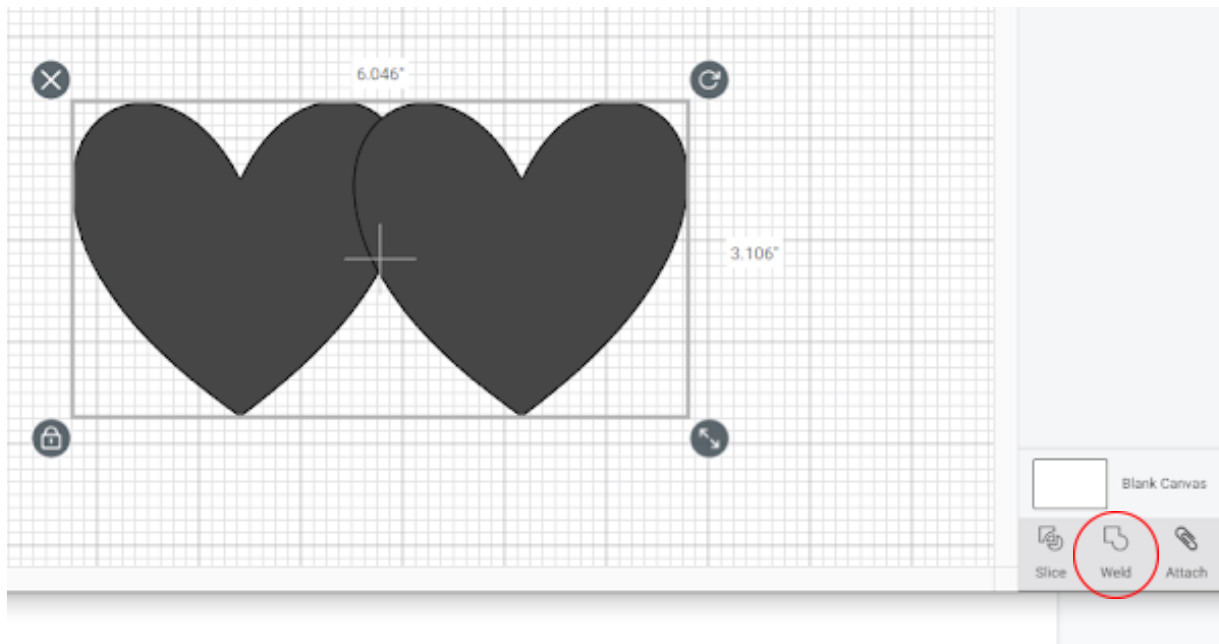
***Do not move the hearts or change their size after this!**

They are perfectly aligned now.

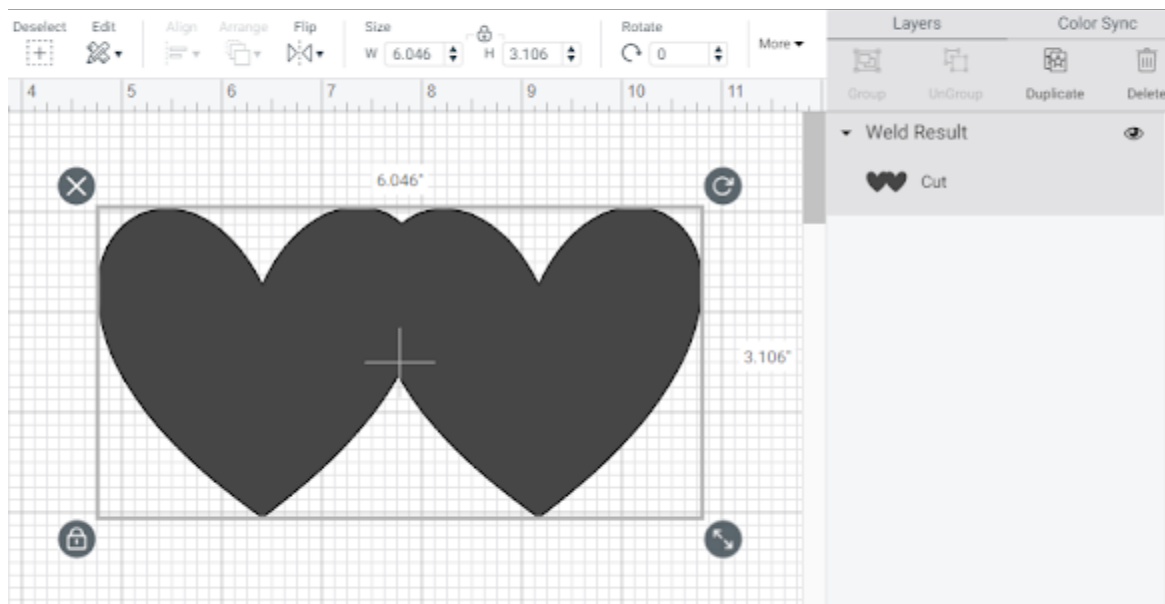


Step 6

With both the heart layers still selected together, “Weld” them together.

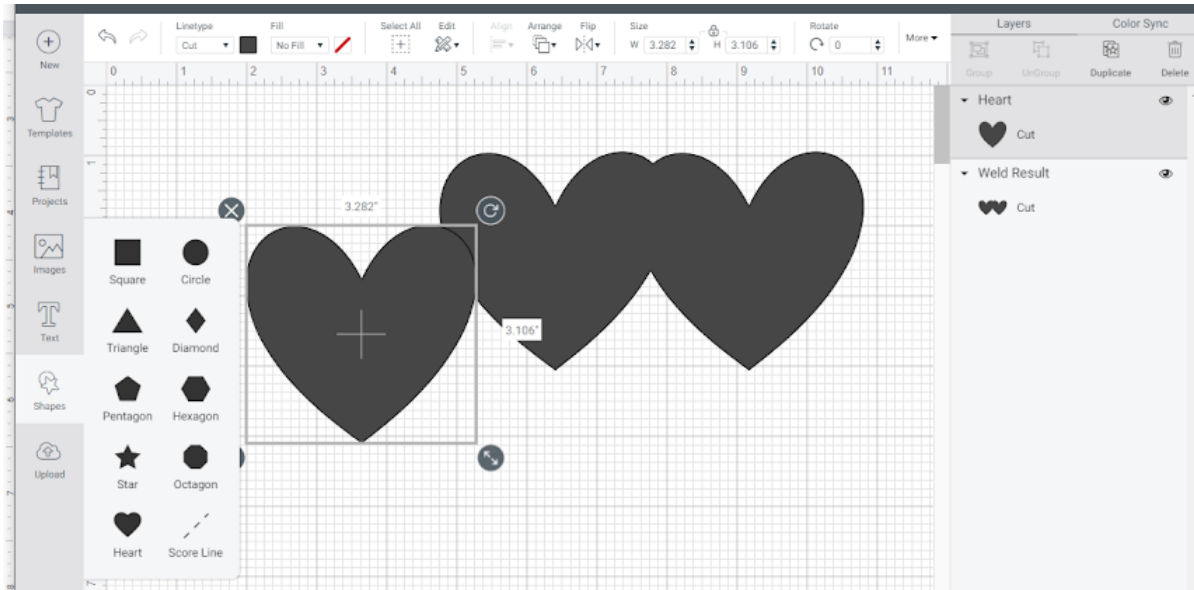


It should look like this now:

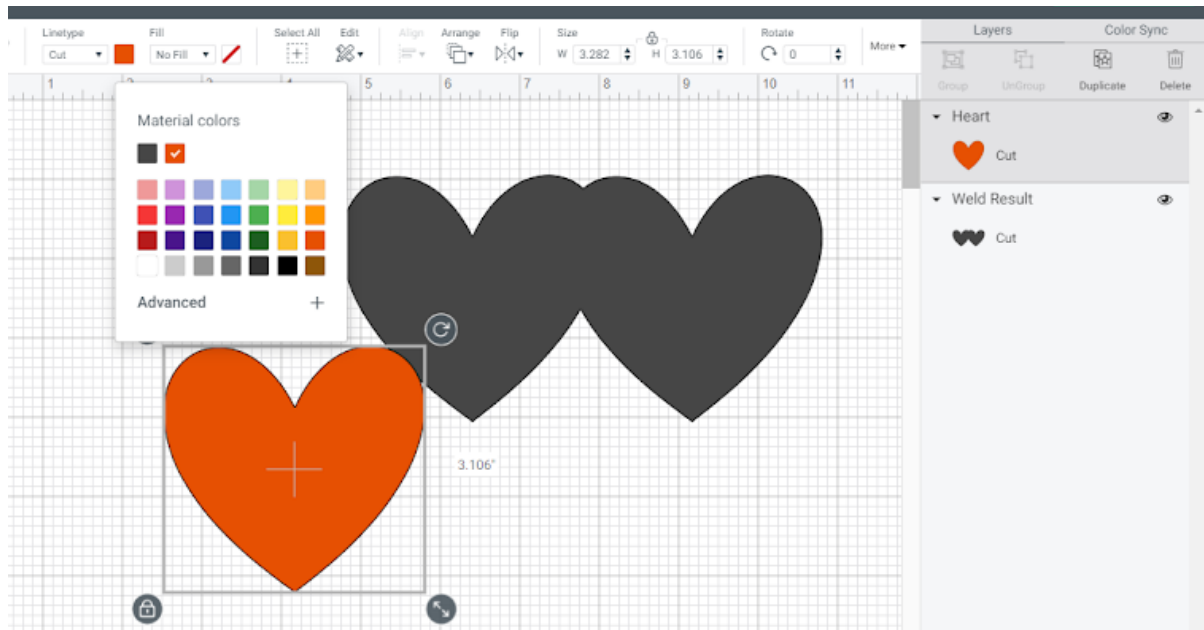


Step 7

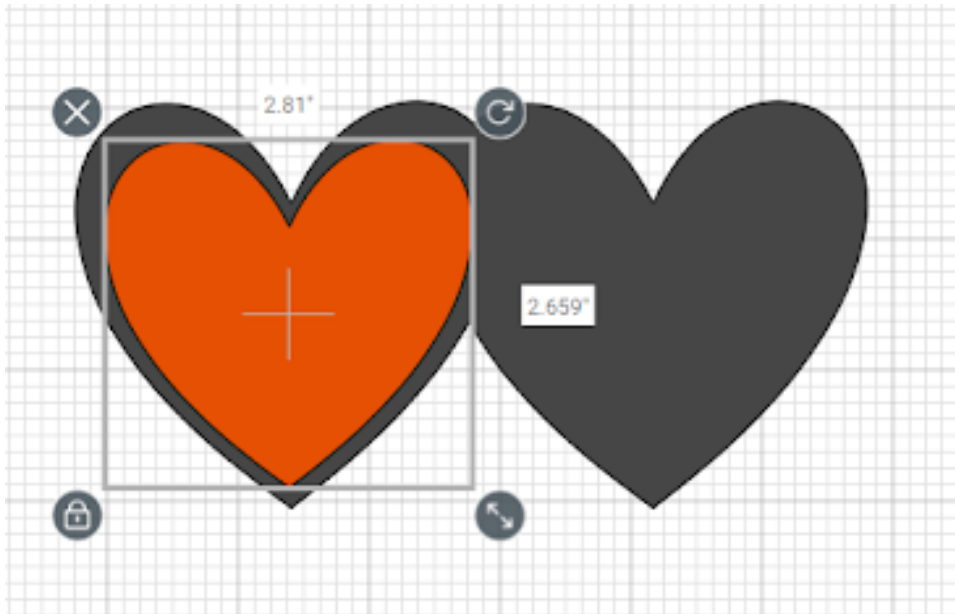
Add a new heart shape layer.



Change the color of this layer so that it is easier to see.

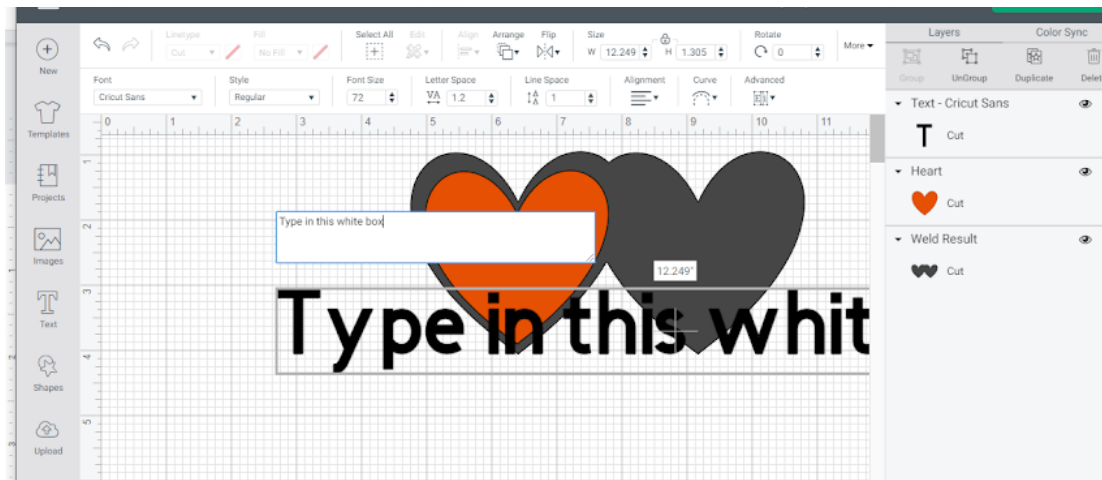


Make this layer about an inch smaller than the first heart layer.
You can drag it over the first heart layer to see the size difference.



Step 8

Add a text layer. (Click the text icon in the menu on the left sidebar.)
Type in the white box.

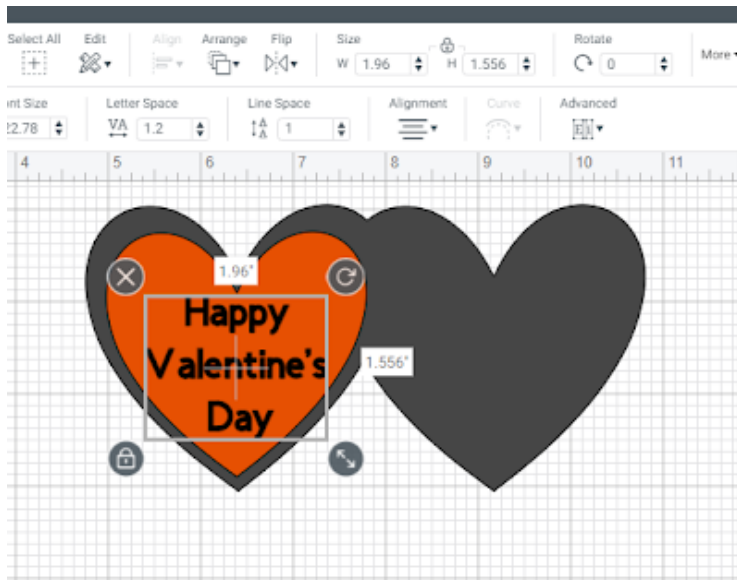


Change your font and text size to what you want.
Notice that there are fonts for purchase. Change the filter to "System" to only view free fonts.



Step 9

Drag and fit your text over the second heart layer (the one you changed the color).

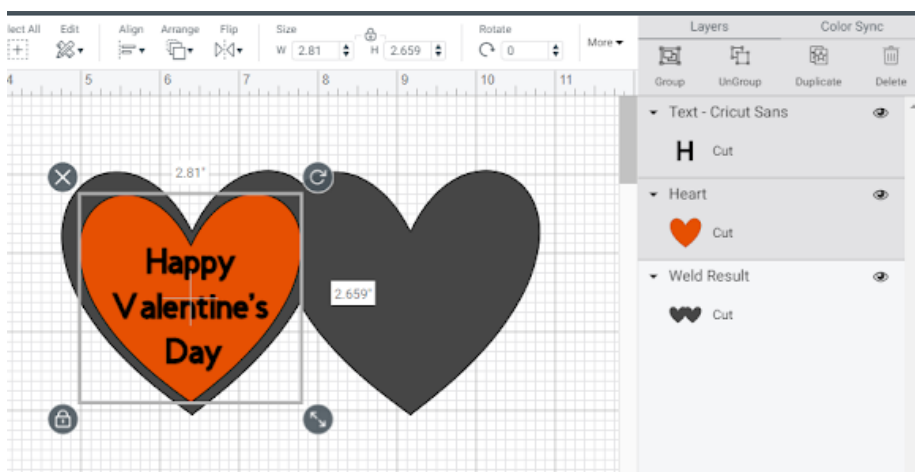


In my example here, I changed the text Alignment to center. I also used the enter key to put the text on separate lines.

***Only continue to Step 10 if you are finished with your text layer.
You cannot change the size or font after this.**

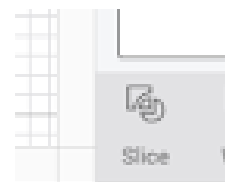
Step 10

Hold shift and select the second heart layer and the text layer.



You will know that they are both selected when those two layers are grey in the right side menu.

“Slice” the text out of the second heart layer.



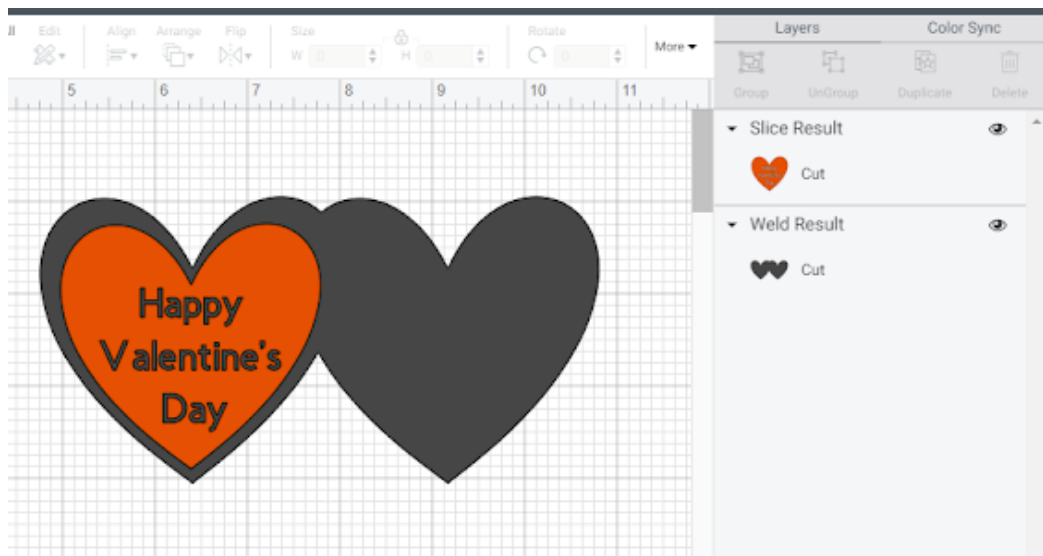


At first, it may look like nothing happened.

However, your layer menu on the right should look like this now:

Step 11

Delete the two text layers.



Your layer menu should look like this now.
